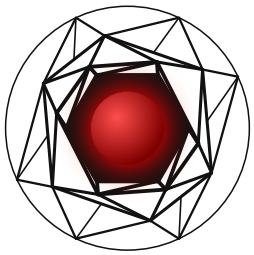

Every work begins with a single thought about human existence. We are, at our core, seekers -constantly navigating the inevitable crossroads of our lives, searching for the right decision.

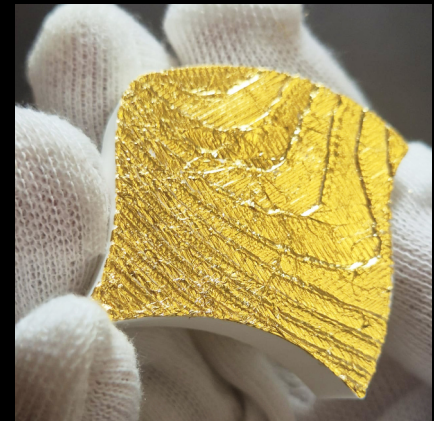
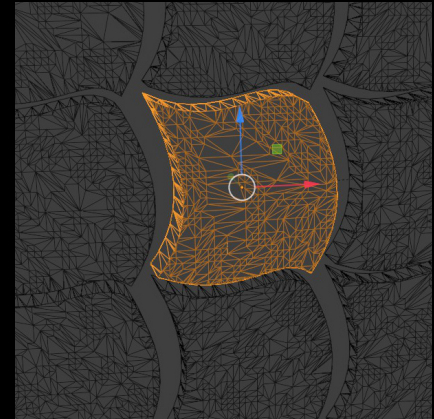
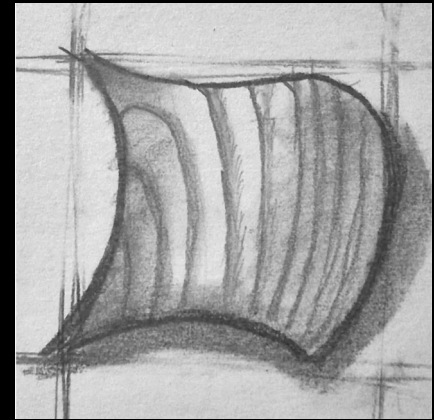

sphere of life

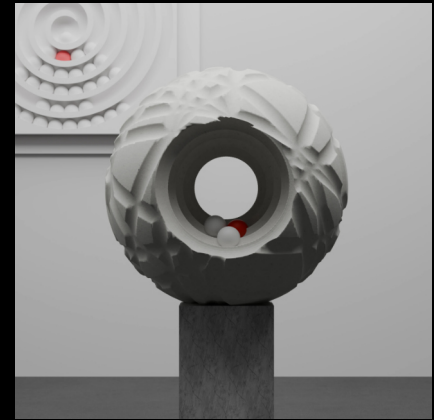
centre your inner worlds

Sphere of Life carries its strength in silence—a calm center in motion. It speaks of the inner world we inhabit, and how it shapes who we are and who we may become.

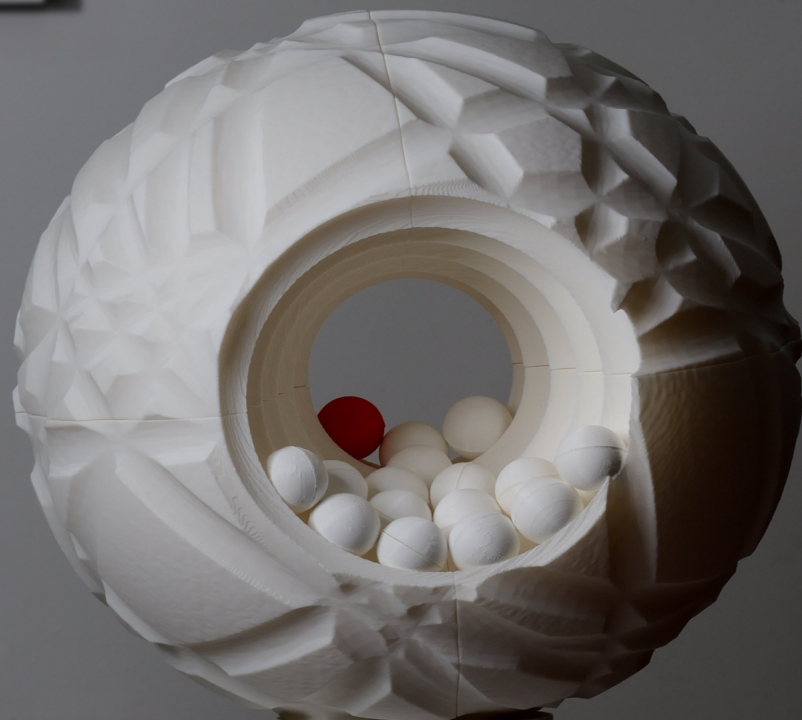

a very personal suite of works

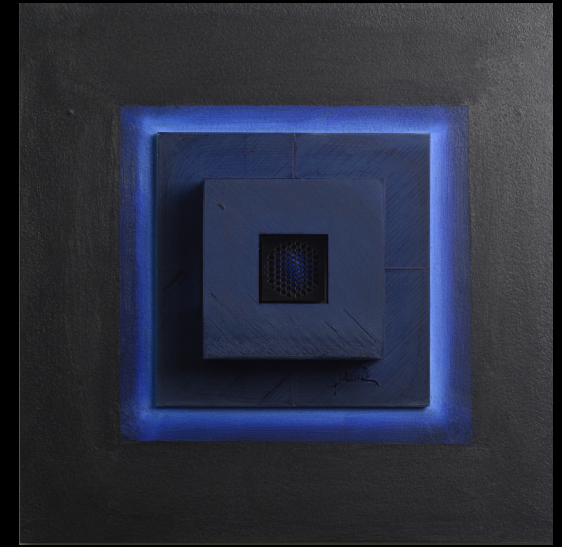
... I truly believed I had overcome the loss - ready to close the book. Looking forward, starting to enjoy life again.

A little later, unexpectedly and uninvited, this feeling came knocking at my door again: emptiness. It was back - that unbearable, cold emptiness. That is when I started drawing. I processed my thoughts into drawings, and later, into sculptures. The contemplation and the loss made me grow into a different person. There was no reason to close the book anymore.

I learned a truth that still defines my life: The worst thing in my life was losing my brother - and yet, it has given me a deeper meaning to life, too.

I refused to let it be meaningless. My brother did not die in vain. His absence became the force that shaped my inner world - the reason I create, the reason every sculpture exists. This sentence may shock some, and perhaps only a few will truly understand it. It is my deeply personal way back to life.

But what really counts is the decision I made: my brother lives on in my thoughts. He accompanies me, and even as we grow older, he remains my big brother.
